

Flower Tower Planting Guide

CHOOSE PLANTS THAT ARE COMPACT, IE. STANDARD 2" POTS. THE FLEXIBLE HOLE DESIGN WILL ALLOW SLIGHTLY LARGER PLANTS, JUST ENSURE THAT THE ROOT BALL DOES NOT PUSH ON THE INTERNAL WATERING TUBE

The plant varieties below have all been successfully grown by us. When planting bush or trailing Tomatoes in a Flower Tower, we suggest planting in only two holes per tier as they are fibrous rooting and have a huge spread.
